REVERSE AUCTION Nº 240755/CABW/2024
MEETING MINUTES 01/240755/CABW/2024

At 10:00 a.m. (EST), on December 24th, 2024, the Brazilian Aeronautical Commission's (BACW) Bidding Commission held a meeting for a Reverse Auction n. 240755/CABW/2024, to be awarded based on the LOWEST PRICE to select the most advantageous proposal for the Purchase of six PRATT & WHITNEY engines model PT6A-34 in OVERHAULED condition, with the possibility of exchanging six expired engines of the same model, in accordance with the conditions, quantities and requirements set out in the Public Notice, in the Term of Reference 25/PAMASP/2024 and its annexes.

The Bidding Process has been published on the Brazilian Air Force's, BACW's and BACE's websites, and on the Brazilian Official Gazette (DOU). For instance, on BACW's website the publishing of this bidding process had been visualized around 116 (one hundred and sixteen) times previously to the time of this meeting.

Furthermore, the company AEROSPACE ACCESSORY SERVICES, INC (Aerospace). sent a representant in person to attend the Bidding. Mrs. Patricia Regina Galhardoni was accredited to represent the company.

The auctioneer received the envelopes containing the price proposal (envelope 1) and the qualification documents (envelope 2). After checking the formal part, he proceeded to negotiate values, with the company agreeing to reduce the price offered for each engine by US\$5,000.00.

As a result, Aerospace was awarded the best offer for each of the engines with the following values after negotiation:

The bidder was asked to send its adjusted proposal (annex 2) to the last value offered and within 1 working day, as well as the technical documentation of the engines offered.

It was confirmed that the company will accept receipt of the core engines, as stated in the Tender and Annexes as part of the payment.

No other offers were received and no companies attended the in-person meeting for the Bidding Process. The Contracting Officer suspended the session for further evaluation of the price proposal received.

Having complied with all due legal and administrative procedures, the Contracting Officer closes this first part of this stage of the meeting, from which these minutes are derived, for signature by all meeting participants and subsequent incorporation into Bidding Process ("PAG") No 67102.240755/2024-53.
